Tredegar's **ExtraFlex™** elastic films bring ultimate comfort to personal care with a family of high extension films that have excellent retractive properties. ExtraFlex films can be used as elastics for laminates assembled inline on diaper and pant lines and as stand-alone elastic components (such as waistbands) of hygiene and apparel articles. The films can be produced as flat films or as three-dimensional apertures for breathability and added bulk.
